The extended time format of the workshop allows time for personal growth work, both for the individual and for couples. Those who are in training for certification will have opportunity to practice the role of Director, with Kaya and Georgia's consultation available. - **Understanding sociometry, and its application in the context of the therapeutic group and in work situations and everyday life;**
